



I-20 Request Form for LSA Reactivation for Undergraduates

This form is to be used by LSA undergraduate students who have been away for 2 or more years and have been approved to reactivate their LSA program of study.

You must meet with an International Student and Scholar Advisor (ISSA) to submit this request. If you are currently outside of the US, please send an email to the International Center (IC) (icenter@umich.edu) to initiate this process.

Before submitting this form to the IC, you must complete the LSA Academic Advising Center's "Application for Reactivation" and obtain confirmation of reactivation.

Important notes. Please read.

- If you have been overseas for more than 5 months, you must apply for a new F-1 visa, even if it appears that your F-1 visa is valid. Your new F-1 status begins when you return regardless of how long you were in F-1 status previously. This may have an impact on your employment eligibility for practical training.
- You may enter the US no more than 30 days before the begin date indicated on the I-20. Students with a transfer pending I-20 are not subject to the 30-day rule.
- If you have been out of the country for more than 5 months, please plan for additional time to receive the I-20, apply for an F-1 visa, and enter the US before your anticipated start date.
- After gaining F status, you must meet with an ISSA at the IC for Check-In.

Checklist of required documents.

- Copy of your passport page(s) showing your picture, biographical information, and its expiration date
- Copy of the front side of your current I-94 card
- Copy of your current I-20 (pages 1 & 3)
- Copy of your approved LSA Reactivation Application or Email
- An unofficial transcript downloaded from [Wolverine Access](#)
- A completed [Financial Resources Statement](#) and supporting financial documents
- Optional: If you will have F-2 dependents, complete and submit the form to [Add F-2 Dependents](#)
- Optional: If you would like your form shipped to you, follow the [Express Mail Through eShip Global](#) instructions.

- I certify I have read the request form instructions and information in full.
- I certify the information I have provided is, to the best of my knowledge, accurate.
- I understand I (and any F-2 dependents) must have U-M approved health insurance for the duration of my F-1 status.
- I understand I must report any address changes, current (U.S.) or permanent (out of U.S.), through Wolverine Access within 10 days of the change.
