- Need to regain F-1 status through reinstatement or travel
- Are an F-3 continuing Canadian commuter student
- Are a continuing student changing status to F-1
- Are a continuing student who will be transferring back to U-M after a short absence

Do not use this form if you are a new student. Do not use this form if you are a continuing student being admitted to a new program at U-M. Please contact your admitting department for an I-20.

Important notes. Please read.

- If you have been overseas for more than 5 months or your reinstatement has been denied, you must apply for a new F-1 visa, even if it appears that your F-1 visa is valid. Your new F-1 status begins when you return regardless of how long you were in F-1 status previously. This may have an impact on your employment eligibility for practical training.
- You may enter the US no more than 30 days before the begin date indicated on the I-20. Students with a transfer pending I-20 are not subject to the 30-day rule.
- If you have been out of the country for more than 5 months, please plan for additional time to receive the I-20, apply for an F-1 visa, and enter the US before your anticipated start date.
- After gaining F status, you must meet with an ISSA at the IC for Check-In.

- Copy of your passport page(s) showing your picture, biographical information, and its expiration date
- Copy of the front side of your current I-94 card
- Copy of your current I-20 (pages 1 & 3), if you have one
- An unofficial transcript downloaded from [Wolverine Access](#)
- A completed [Financial Resources Statement](#) and supporting financial documents

- Optional: If you will have F-2 dependents, complete and submit the form to [Add F-2 Dependents](#)

- *I certify I have read the request form instructions and information in full.*
- *I certify the information I have provided is, to the best of my knowledge, accurate.*
- *I understand I (and any F-2 dependents) must have U-M approved health insurance for the duration of my F-1 status.*
- *I understand I must report any address changes, current (U.S.) or permanent (out of U.S.), through Wolverine Access within 10 days of the change.*
