

Application Process for Non-UM Programs

Most study abroad programs that are not sponsored by the University of Michigan require prospective students to fill out an application. Applications may require additional fees, essays, recommendations and a GPA requirement.

When filling out program applications:

- Follow program protocol and apply directly to the program; check-in with your school or college academic advisor(s).
- Inform program sponsors that an official transcript of your academic work will need to be sent to:
