## Overview: Summary of All Data

During Fall term 2023, a total of 12,720 international students, scholars, faculty and staff studied or worked at the University of Michigan (U-M). The International Center (IC) provides a wide range of services and programs for these individuals to assist them in achieving their academic, professional and personal goals. In addition, the IC supports 861 dependents in F-2 or J-2 status as well as dependents of international faculty and staff through advising and programming efforts.

## Summary of Student Data

U-M enrolled 8,812 international students from 132 countries during Fall 2023. Most of these enrolled students are F-1 or J-1 students, but this total includes international students holding other types of visas as well. The International Center also served an additional 2,067 students participating in post-completion optional practical training (full-time work authorization after completion of studies).

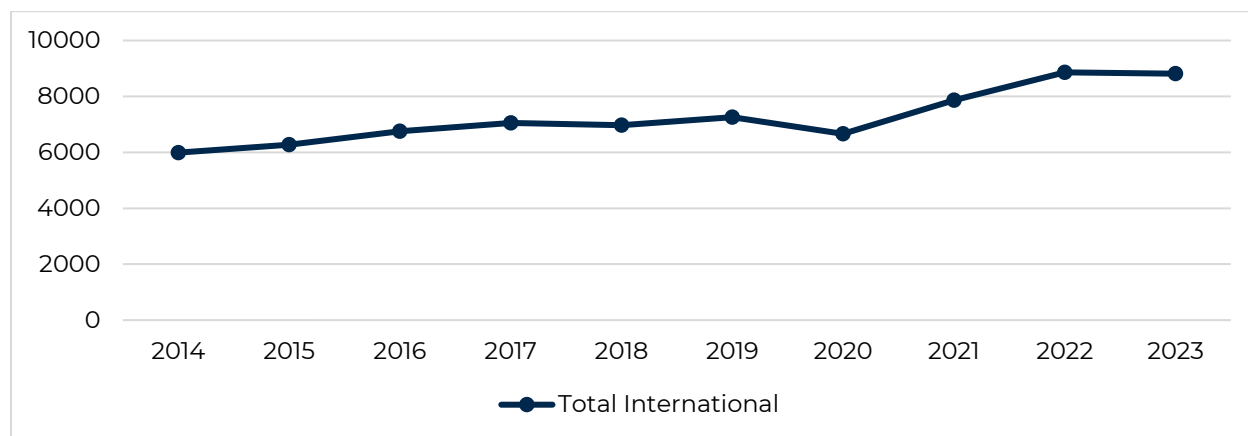
According to the 2023 *Open Doors* report from the Institute of International Education (IIE) based on Fall 2022 data, U-M ranked 11<sup>th</sup> nationally among all universities (6<sup>th</sup> among public research institutions) in terms of hosting international students. Since that report includes both enrolled students and those on post-completion Optional Practical Training, it indicates that U-M hosted 10,411 international students in Fall 2022 rather than the 8,861 reported as enrolled by the International Center based on 2022 Fall Term enrollment data from the Office of the Registrar. ## Economic Impact

According to NAFSA's International Student Economic Value Tool based on IIE's Open Doors data for Fall 2022, the U-M international student community (students and dependents) contributed an estimated \$505.1 million to the local economy. 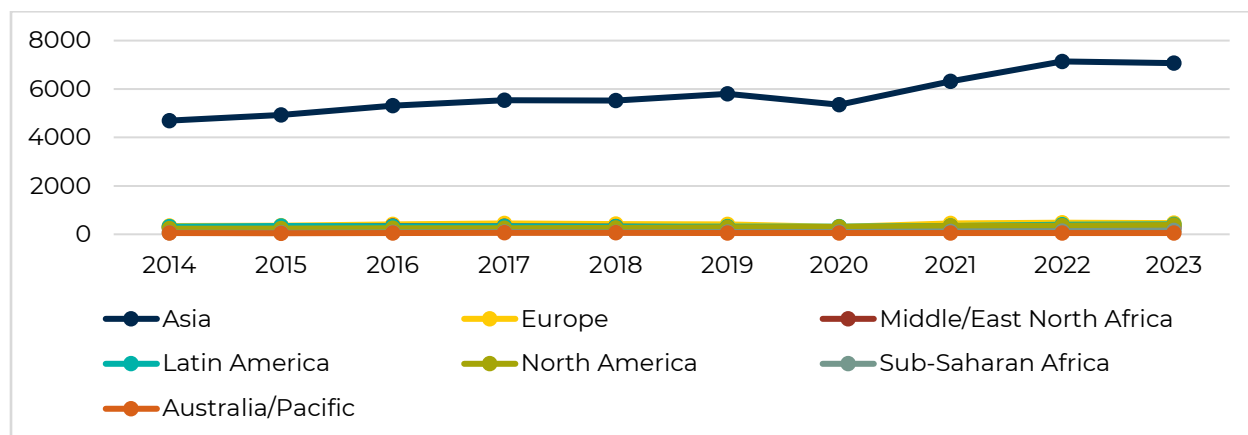

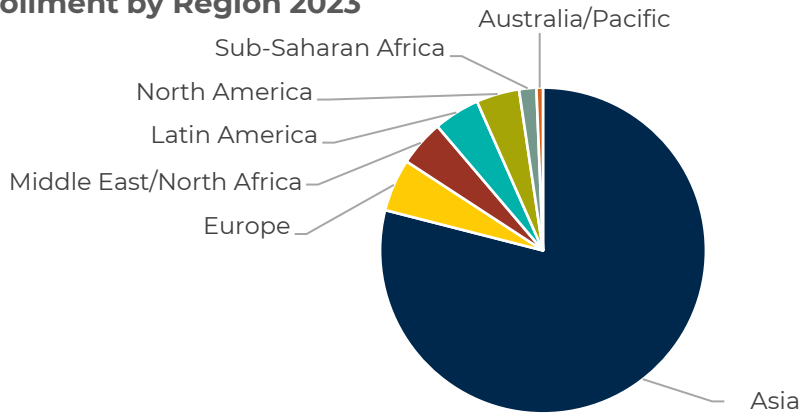

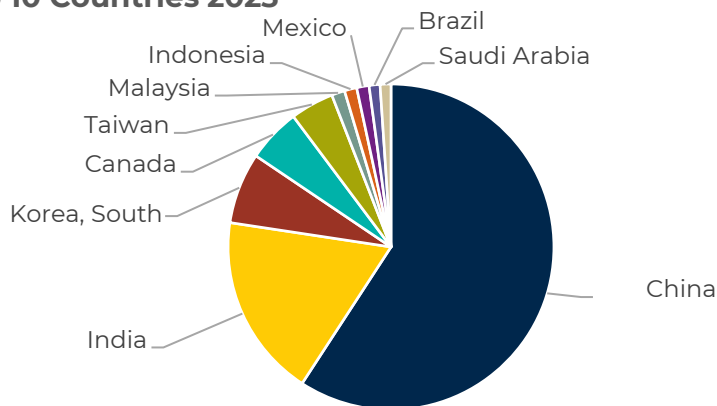

## Summary of International Employee Data

International employees are individuals on non-immigrant (temporary) visas who have university appointments. The IC oversees all immigration casework necessary for those on H-1B, TN, E-3 and J-1 visas and provides a wide range of services and programs for these individuals and their families. The IC also assists university departments by filing immigrant visa petitions for foreign nationals offered permanent teaching positions and/or research faculty positions. The IC refers to outside counsel for all others who are offered permanent employment at U-M.

**In Fall Term 2023, there were 1,499 international employees at U-M** (698 on H-1B visas, 408 on J-1 visas, and 393 on other non-immigrant visas including TN, E-3, O-1, and F-1 students on OPT sponsored by other U.S. institutions). In addition to these employees, there were 342 visiting scholars without university appointments for a total scholar/employee population of 1,841.

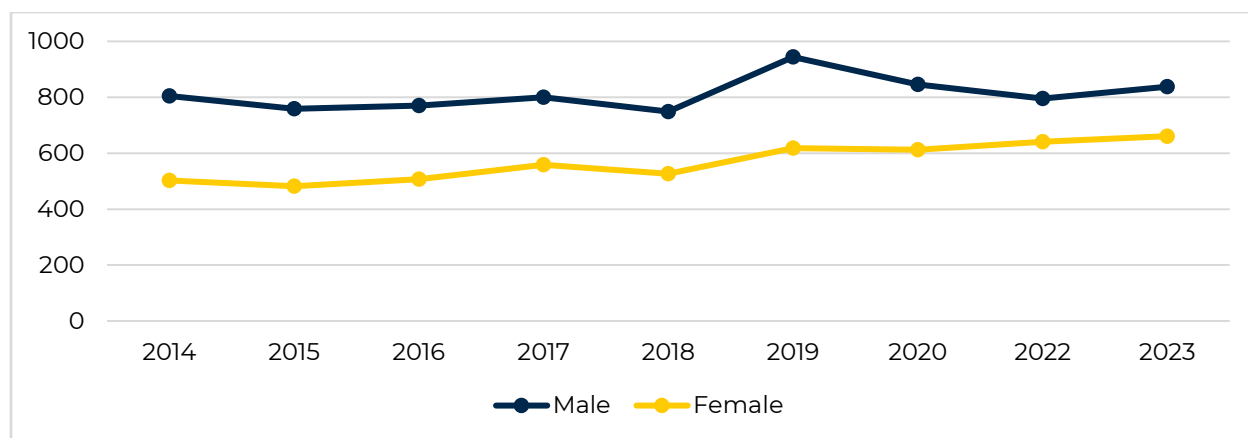
- Beginning in 2019, U-M employees on F-1 Optional Practical under the visa sponsorship of another higher education institution have been included in the international employee section of this report. Since their immigration documents were issued by another higher education institution, not by U-M, they are not included in the count of U-M sponsored F-1 OPT students that appears in the international student section of this report.
- In addition to employees in the various nonimmigrant statuses, the University of Michigan also employs a substantial number of foreign-born US citizens and legal permanent residents (i.e. green card holders). Note that these employees

are not included in the international employee total in this report. These individuals work in a wide array of academic and non-academic positions.

- Data for 2021 is not available.

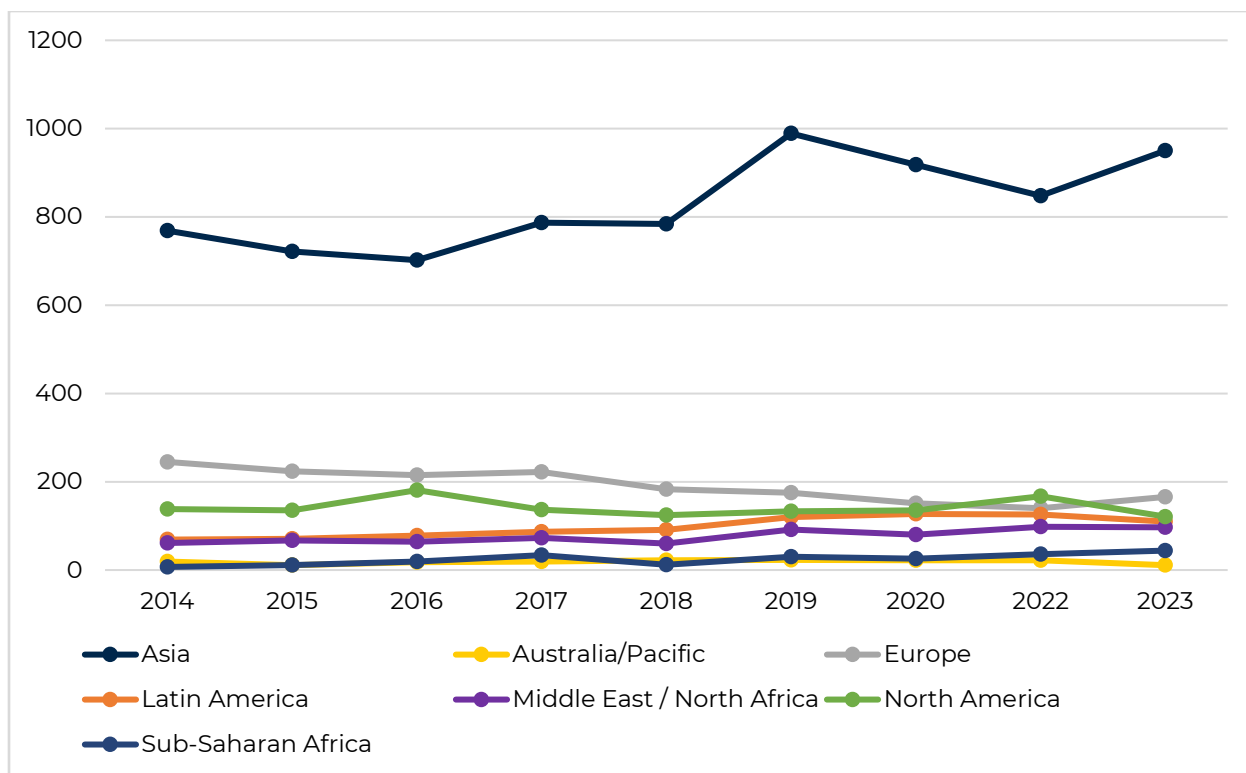

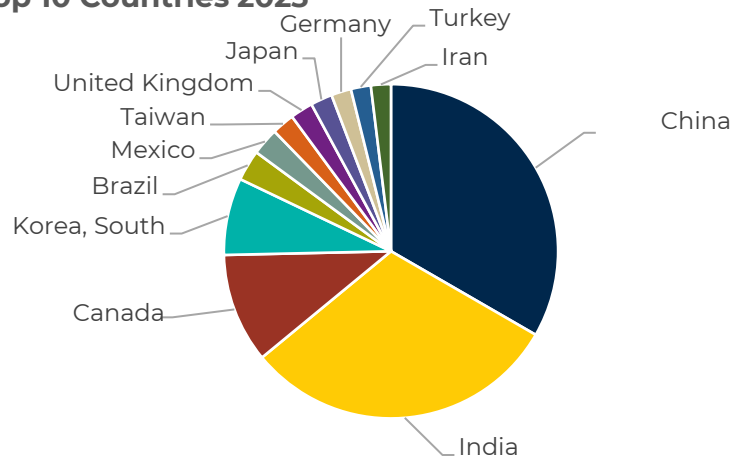
