



7. Arrival and Beyond



ARRIVAL

Private transportation will bring each intern to their accommodation upon arrival.

ACADEMIC CREDIT

- School of Record (SOR): The Forum on Education Abroad defines this as "a U.S. accredited institution of higher education that officially documents and awards credits for programs or institutions that are not accredited in the U.S." The school of record verifies and documents the educational value of the program, and issues a transcript to students, documenting their completion of the "course" and the credits earned. The school of record charges a fee for this service.
- Florida A&M University serves as TIG's SOR
- \$450 USD added to the internship program fee
- Number of credits varies by number of weeks of internship + institutional requirements

1 week = 1 credit


Earn anywhere between 3-9 credits

- All academic credit requests must be sent to academic.credit@theinterngroup.com
- Rule to live by: Student should always ask their academic advisor before enrolling with our SOR, as approval can vary by major and institution.




