

- FREE! No ID required.
- Routes between Central, North, and South campuses



- \$1.50
- Farther away from Ann Arbor
 - Michigan Flyer (bus) & shuttles to Metro Detroit Airport and East Lansing.
 - Amtrak (train) and Greyhound & Megabus (bus)


