Virtual International Internships...

May provide flexible working hours

 Can be a more affordable way to gain international work experience

- Provide an opportunity to gain project-based work experience
- Allow you to learn about the culture of the company and the country it's located in

Differences between virtual and traditional international internships

 Complementary, not interchangeable experiences

- Discipline, focus, and strong initiative required
- Ability to connect with colleagues during the workday may be impacted by time zones and physical distance.



Step by Step Process (example)

- 1. Apply
 - a. Provider interview
- 2. Accept
- 3. Enroll \$\$\$
- 4. Prepare
 - a. Provider advises, assesses your skills, matches you with an employer, etc.
- 5. Employer Interview
- 6. Intern


